The year 2014 is here! This turn of the calendar marks an excellent time for each of us to pause and not just make our New Year Resolutions, but carefully consider our personal pattern of Spiritual meditation with God. Since we are all different; the times, locations, and methods we use may vary. And that's good. We each need to discover what best enables us to come into his presence with prayer and private worship.

We also can do that in many ways using many resources. Of course, the central text is the Bible. A good Bible reading plan is most helpful. A number of good ones are available, whether it's read the Bible through or use a devotional text from a resource. I have personally always found it better not to use too large a section, which enables me to really focus on what is being said in the text - and what God might be saying to me. At LBC for many years we have provided a variety of devotional readings for those who enjoy the pattern of readings and prayers. I hope you find them helpful. Your feedback is always welcomed on those resources.

Additionally a number of other resources are available, including many online resources easily accessible at our disposal. Each morning while having morning coffee, I meditate on four different devotional readings delivered by my email. One of them is a devotional quote of the day from Heartlight. (HOW DO I SUB-SCRIBE? Send a blank email to: quotemeal-subscribe@maillists.heartlight.org) These quotes from many sources allow me to read, reflect, and apply. I take it with me and often revisit and I save my favorites for ongoing reflection.

As a New Year's reflection, I list a few of the many quotes that have been especially meaningful to me. Take time to just read them, slow down and ask what God may be saying personally to you and your life in those words. Where does it touch you, shape you, and does it call you to respond in any way?
