Youth will be meeting only on Sunday **April 23rd** at 5:00 P.M. for dinner and Bible study this month due to Easter.



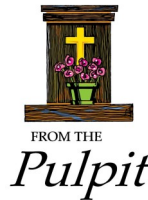
Young Family Bible Study

LENT ACTIVITIES



Easter is almost here! Easter is such a special time of the year, especially when we allow the Lenten season to prepare our hearts. Here at Littleton Baptist, we truly embrace this Lenten season. We use this in preparation for the season of Easter.

One of the biggest events of this season is our Lenten Lunches in partnership with the other community churches such as Lakeside Lutheran, Littleton United Methodist Church, Roanoke Chapel, and South Street Baptist Church. It is a time where we gather not as individual churches, but as one church body to remember the death and resurrection of Jesus. We come together for lunch with each host church providing desserts and drinks. Then one of the preachers from the various churches delivers a message. This is a special time in the community as we come together.

2022 also saw a new addition to our Lenten activities with an Ash Wednesday service. Ash Wednesday is the official beginning of Lent. As part of Lenten Lunches, we have always had an Ash Wednesday service. But that year, we decided to have a night service for those who were unable to attend the lunches. That continued this year and will continue through the years.

As the season continues, we come to Holy Week. Palm Sunday has been a special part with the children waving palm branches. On the Thursday before Easter we gather together for Maundy Thursday with a service including communion to remember the death of Jesus. The Saturday before Easter, our children gather for an Easter Egg hunt and to hear a devotion about Easter.

And then we come to Easter morning! Easter morning starts with a sunrise service. And as we know the sun always rises at 7:00 AM here in Littleton. We then have a breakfast hosted by our missions committee. And then the main event! During our 11:00 AM worship time on Easter morning our choir presents their yearly cantata. They sing songs to teach the message of the cross and empty tomb.

Allow us to make these Lenten services a part of our identity, as we enter into the future of Littleton Baptist Church.
