PASTOR'S PARAGRAPH

Recently James Kearney brought me a humorous gem from a news article that has long been making the rounds in church news. It is a good one that gives us some food for thought; after all getting up and going to church every Sunday morning is sometimes not that easy even for the truly devout, and it is made more difficult for the rest.

The article is entitled, "No Excuse Sunday," and reads as follows: "To make it possible for everyone to attend church, we will soon be having a "No Excuse Sunday." Cots will be placed in the foyer for those who say, "Sunday is my only day to sleep late. Murine will be available for those tired eyes from watching TV too late on Saturday night. We will have steel helmets for those who say, 'The roof would cave in if I ever went to church.' Blankets will be furnished for those who say the church is too cold and fans for those who say it is too hot. We will have hearing aids for those who say, 'the pastor speaks too softly', and cotton for those who say 'the pastor speaks too loudly.' Scorecards will be available for those who wish to list all the hypocrites present. There will be 100 TV dinners for those who cannot go to church and cook dinner. One section will be devoted to trees and grass for those who like to seek God in nature. While this may be overstating the case a bit, it does give us something significant to consider. "Just why do I spend my Sunday mornings gathering to assemble with other believers to worship God?" Or perhaps the question may be "why do I not gather on a regular basis?" It is a question we need to ponder! A lot of reasons may come to the surface.

- I gather because God is worthy of my best act of worship and I want to give Him honor and praise.
- I gather because I desire to learn more about His word and how to serve him with my life.
- I gather because I draw strength in the Christians I worship alongside.
- I gather because nothing brings me joy and peace more than the regular assembling together with other Christians.
- I gather because I want my life to be a witness to others by my gathering regularly with other believers.
- You are invited to prayerfully consider other motivations for gathering even when it's difficult to get moving.

To the other question, "why do I not gather on a regular basis?" I can't cover all the reasons, some of which are that my health is poor or my job prevents me at times, and more. I just can't get there. Only you will know why not? Prayerfully consider what hinders you and consider assembling next Sunday! Is there something I can change to make that possible? Either way, know you've been missed and we need you as part of the "body of Christ."

Hebrews 10:25 states: Let us not give up the habit of meeting together, as some are doing. Instead, let us encourage one another all the more, since you see that the Day of the Lord is coming nearer. As we continue in the Season of Lent and approach Easter Sunday on April 20, I encourage you to gather regularly for worship prepared to encounter the living Lord! I know God will bless!


