## **PASTOR'S PARAGRAPH**

As we enter into the month of March, we will be entering into the season of Lent. Lent is a special time in the church year, as we prepare our hearts for Good Friday, and ultimately Easter. This is a season of self-reflection. It is a time when many people fast to draw themselves closer to God.

Ultimately, Lent is about our connection to God. It is about understanding the true purpose of the cross. We remember when Jesus died, and the temple curtain was torn in two, symbolizing that we have an open door between us and God. Now we can come to him and be forgiven of our sins. Jesus was our ultimate sacrifice.

Jesus did so much for us than just die. Before he died, Jesus lived on this Earth for 33 years. Three of those years he spent doing ministry. He spent that time teaching, healing, and showing the world what it really means to follow God. Jesus did so much for us in what he said and did. Sometimes those things get swept under the rug to just focus on his birth and death. Maybe we should spend a little more time focusing on how Jesus taught us to live.

So during Lent this year we will do just that. Jesus most famous sermon or teaching moment that he had was the Sermon on the Mount. Throughout Lent we will spend time focusing on this sermon. We will examine different aspects of it as we listen to the words of Jesus, teaching us what it truly means to follow him and have that genuine connection to God. The third Sunday of March will be Baptist Women in Ministry Sunday. This Sunday is set aside so that we celebrate those women who are called into ministry and give support to those women that they have a place preaching God's word. Our guest preacher will be Rev. Ka'thy Chappell, the Executive Director of Baptist Women in Ministry of NC.

The next two Sundays we will be continuing our series on the Sermon on the Mount by looking at what it means to be the salt and light of the Earth. We will then conclude March by looking at how we can avoid being wolves in sheep's clothing.

The words of Jesus are important. We should never forget what Jesus actually teaches and the message that he teaches. He came to show us the way. Let us follow him.


