Good News

We all love to hear it, don't we? As a matter of fact, we are thrilled to hear good news when so much of the news is tragic, or even frightening. Finding good news in our various forms of media can be a major challenge. During this past month, known as "March Madness," various teams have suffered defeat, some even characterized as "upsets."

When Jesus was crucified, the disciples and all the others who had followed Jesus, were beyond being discouraged. They were heart-broken and defeated. After all, in their minds the cause was lost. Jesus had been their master teacher, the one who had performed miracles in their midst, the one who spoke as no one ever had. Now, all hope was gone. It had vanished that Friday night on the cross—that horrible means of execution by inflicting a slow, agonizing death. How could that have happened to the one whom they loved, who seemed so perfect in every way. What would they do? What could they do? It was over.
