### THOUGHTS ALONG THE WAY

#### PROMISES

Many times throughout our lives we have made promises, or had promises made to us. It is important that promises be kept. Many promises have been made in the Scripture.

Jesus is still an infant. Mary and Joseph have taken him to the temple in Jerusalem to be presented to the Lord, as required by the Law of Moses. It has been revealed to Simeon that he would not die before he had seen the Lord's Messiah. Luke 2:28 - 32 tells us what happened:

Simeon took him in his arms and praised God, saying:

"Sovereign Lord, as you have promised, you may now dismiss your servant in peace. For my eyes have seen your salvation, which you have prepared in the sight of all nations: A light for revelation to the Gentiles, and the glory of your people Israel"

The main thought that we take away from this experience is that God always keeps his promises. God may tarry long beyond the time we pray for, but God never breaks his promise. Simeon proved that in his prayer.

I will not try to list all the promises of God listed in the Bible, but here are some of them.

Matthew 7:7: "Ask, and it shall be given to you; seek and you shall find; knock, and it shall be opened to you" (NASB).

Matthew 10:32: "Whoever acknowledges me before others, I will also acknowledge before my Father in heaven. But whoever disowns me before others, I will disown before my Father in heaven" (NIV).

Matthew 28:20: "Lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age" (NASB).

Mark 9:41: "Truly I tell you, anyone who gives you a cup of water in my name because you belong to the Messiah will certainly not lose their reward" (NIV).

John 8:12: "When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, 'I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life" (NIV).

John 10:27 - 28: "My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish, and no one shall ever snatch them out of my hand" (NIV).

Every one of these promises applies to us. We can count on them, just as surely as spring follows winter. Indeed, I think spring has never been more beautiful, or more welcomed. Thanks be to God.
